## Poster Guidelines

Document your activity on a Poster Board (22" x 28"). Be sure to include the following:

1. MY ACTIVITY Describe what happened at your activity.  
Include *Who, What, When, Where* and Why.
2. THE OUTCOME Describe your thoughts about the activity's outcome.  
How successful was it? How did it make you feel?
3. THE EFFECT ON MY AUDIENCE Describe how your audience reacted. If possible, have them write a brief description of how it made them feel and include this paper on your poster.
4. TWO QUOTES Somewhere on the poster, include TWO different quotes about helping or giving to others:
  1. An existing quote that is meaningful to you: "*A life isn't significant except for its impact on others.*"

  2. An original quote, written by you: "?????? ?? ????? ????? ???? ??"  
-- Your Name

PRESENTATION: All information on you poster should be clear and easy to read.

Include photos of your activity. Feel free to add illustrations, music and other artwork!
